Complaints and protest	 A complaint can be filed orally or in writing to the event director by contacting the event office. A complaint must be lodged as early as possible and at the latest at the end of the event. This means 30 minutes after the last finish or the expiry of the maximum time for the last starter in the competition. Protests against a decision made by the event director in a complaint case must be submitted to the jury chairman by contacting the event office. A protest can only be filed by the participant(s) who is directly affected by the event director's decision. The protest should be submitted in writing to the jury. The protest must be submitted no later than 30 minutes after notification of a complaint's decision.
