All three races are IOF World Ranking Event for Women and Men Elite.

Konventum, Helsingør, scale 1:4.000 offsetprinted and revised in 2014. Contour interval 2.5 m.

Varied area with park, residential, lawns, complicated building complex and a little forrest. 80-90% of the course will take place on soft ground. The rest at hard surfaces like roads and slippery flagged paths.



Event classification

Danish classification. Saturday: C *****, Sunday: A

Description of the terrain

A highly diversified forest with well developed paths, ranging from light to medium undulating, with a detail rich graphical representation and vague run-through options. This chosen forest represents almost all terrain types in Denmark, ranging from flat plantations and open dunes to relative hilly, deciduous forest.



Venue - and how to get there

Directions from road no. 267, wich run trough Tisvildeleje, Hovedgaden and ends at the parking lot at the beach, 25 km north of Hillerød and 60 km north of Copenhagen. Transportation by private cars, train or buses.



Event arena

The arena is within the competition area and provides a unique experience for runners and spectators. The complete event is covered by commentary, online results

The Event arena tents contains the Event information desk and kiosk with tasty small hot and cold dishes as well as beverages and sweets.

General information all 3 days

Punching system

Sportident - all card versions. The same SI-card can be used in all three races.

Children's course

For all children, free of charge, Saturday from 13.00 to 15.30 and Sunday from 9:30 to 12:00.

Accomodation and shower facilities

You can find links to a number of hostels, cabins. hotels etc. on the website. Reservation in due time is recommended. DANISH SPRING cannot offer accomodation.

Shower facilities on Friday and Sunday afternoon will be offered within a short driving distance of the event.

Training

From Tuesday 18th March is offered more attractive training opportunities in the nearby woods. The trainings is with different challenges and course lengths. All controls has reflectors, so courses can also be run as a night training. More info coming on www.danishspring.dk.

Climate

Denmark has a mild climate with no extremes. In March, day temperatures average 6 degrees C. average rainfall is 39 mm and sunshine averages150 hours for the month. The risk of snow in the terrain is small.

Insurance

Insurance is the responsibility of the individual participant. All participation is at your own risk. Do not leave valuables in the tents. Danish Spring does not accept any responsibility for either accidents or for lost or stolen property.

Competition rules

IOF's international competition rules for foot orienteering event 2014 (the WRE relevant part) supplemented by DOF's rules 2013 §§ 2.6 (Shadowing), 2.8 (Embargoed areas), 2.10 (Start rights), 3.2 (Event Classification), 3.10 (controls) og 6.1 (C-events) covering conditions not covered by the IOF rules, plus special rules for participation.



Instruction/Bulletin 2 and start lists

Bulletin 2 and a preliminary list of competitors will be on www.danishspring.dk from 8 March 2014. Start lists will be announced on 14 March 2014.

Entries and payment

Regular entries

Entries must be received by DANISH SPRING no later than 1 March 2014 and the entry fees (via bank transfer) no later than 1 March 2013.

Entries should be made online via the link from www.danishspring.dk. A club can create one, and only one, account. Entries on the club's account on 1 March 2014 are binding.

Joint entries must be done for each club by its representative.

Late entries, changes and vacant starts

Late entries at an extra charge of DKK 50 per start can be made via the online entry system until 18 March 2014 at 14:00 – and during the event as long as vacant starts are available. The entry fee for late entries must be paid (via bank transfer) no later than 18 March 2014 and an electronic receipt must be sent to danishspring@gmail.com.

Direct courses are offered during the Event

Changing of an entry (e.g. name or class) can be done until the start at the Event informa

tion desk in the arena at an extra charge of DKK 50 per start.

Entering and changing of SI-card numbers can be done online until 18 March 2014 at 14.00. Competitors without an SI-card number at that time will be assigned a rental SI-card.

State the club, nationality, name, race, class, SI-card number and possible IOF world ranking ID in the body of the e-mail. E-mail entries/ changes must always be confirmed by DANISH SPRING.
